**Issue:** Some 2018 F-150 equipped with 5.0L engines may exhibit an illuminated MIL with DTCs P0316 and/or P0011, P0012, P0016, P0018, P0021, P0022, P0300, P0301, P0302, P0303, P0304, P0305, P0306, P0307, P0308 stored in powertrain control module (PCM) and exhibit no drivability concerns.

Action: Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

**Warranty Status:** Eligible Under Provisions Of New Vehicle Limited Warranty Coverage And Emissions Warranty Coverage Warranty/ESP coverage limits/policies/prior approvals are not altered by a TSB. Warranty/ESP coverage limits are determined by the identified causal part and verified using the OASIS part coverage tool.

## **Service Procedure**

- 1. Connect the Ford Integrated Diagnostic System (IDS) or Ford J2534 Diagnostic Software (FJDS) to the data link connector (DLC). Check for DTCs. Is P0316 and or P0011, P0012, P0016, P0018, P0021, P0022, P0301, P0302, P0303, P0304, P0305, P0306, P0307, P0308 stored in the PCM?
  - (1). Yes proceed to Step 2.

(2). No - this article does not apply. Refer to the Powertrain Control/Emissions Diagnosis (PC/ED) manual for normal diagnostics.

2. Reprogram the PCM using Integrated Diagnostic System (IDS) or Ford J2534 Diagnostic Software (FJDS) release 108.01 or higher. Make sure you are connected to the internet when entering module programming to obtain the latest updates. Calibration files may also be obtained at www.motorcraftservice.com.
